

2018 - 2019 COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

- **After School Movies** - Twice a year students get to watch a movie in the cafeteria for a small fee. Drinks and snacks will be provided. Volunteers needed to create flyers, monitor children, and pass out snacks.
- **Art Vista** - Art Vistas is a parent-run program that gets art education into our school. All lessons and projects are taught and guided by parent volunteers. Parent volunteers also run the program at the school, ordering supplies, preparing supplies for projects, picking up the prints from the Art Vistas office, putting on the Art Show at the end of the school year, and supporting classroom docents.
- **Bingo Night** - A fun night where families get together and enjoy bingo. The chair will be responsible for coordination of the event as well as finding volunteers to help at the event.
- **Book Fair** - A fundraiser where Scholastic sets up a bookstore in the media center promoting reading and sells books. Volunteers help with the register and overall running of the book fair.
- **Box Tops for Education** - Earning cash for our school with *Box Tops* is easy. Each one is worth 10 cents and you can find them on hundreds of products. It's easy to organize and the money adds up fast.
- **Buy-In Parties & Auctions** - Family fun events that encourage families and/or students getting to know each other. Parties can include teaching a skill or just having fun doing a sport or hobby.
- **Carnival** - A fun community event in the spring full of games, food, and fun activities. Committee members will help plan and coordinate the vendors as well as recruit and manage volunteers for the event.
- **Ceramics** - Each grade level has 2 clay projects per year, one in the fall and one in the spring. Volunteers will help students mold clay, fire the projects in kiln, and then glaze the projects.
- **Chef's Night Out** - Head up coordinating with local restaurants fundraiser nights.

- **Corporate Matching** - Many companies will match donations. It is usually a simple process and can double any donation.

- **Family Dance** - Organize and plan an event to build community and provide a fun event where families can spend time together. Chair will coordinate the event as well as find volunteers to help during the event.

- **Ice Cream Social** - Usually in the beginning of the school year to celebrate a new year, encouraging students and their families to build community.
- **My School Anywhere Directory** - Encourage families to sign up for directory and approve entries. Maintain database for accurate information.
- **Olympic Day** - Help bring the spirit of the Olympic Games to Guadalupe! Starting with opening ceremonies, Olympic Day continues with students participating in friendly sporting events. Volunteer will coordinate set up of games, verifying instructions, organize stations, and soliciting volunteers to run stations.
- **Project Cornerstone** - Volunteers read to students 6 times throughout the year stories that facilitate positive self-esteem, problem solving techniques, and acceptance of differences. Readers will need training in order to be a reader and will help prepare lesson plans provided by Project Cornerstone.
- **Room Parent Coordinator** - This volunteer acts as a liaison between GHSC and room parents. Help support room parents perform their commitments throughout the year.

- **Spirit Wear** -Responsible for maintaining online store and advertising available merchandise through school publications. No inventory will be kept so all orders will be filled directly online.
- **Teacher Time and Talent** - Teachers offer their time or talent and are auctioned off at the basket auction. Chair is responsible for communicating with the teachers and helping to coordinate the event.
- **Walkathon** -The biggest fundraiser of the year. Students walk laps to earn money for our school. Volunteers will help to coordinate prizes and incentives, create flyers and banners, assist in collection, mark laps, and create a fun and spirited even to keep kids motivated and excited for the event.
- **Webmaster** - Maintain and update the GHSC website by working with the school and the GHSC to make sure all the correct information is available, in a timely manner, to the school, staff and the parent community.
- **Winterfest** - Fun event of the year celebrating reading and Guadalupe's community. Teachers will promote reading by reading to the students and facilitate fun activities. The event will take place at the end of the book fair. There will also be a silent auction/basket auction.
- **Yearbook** - Collect and yearbook pages from classroom yearbook volunteers. Work with yearbook company to put together the yearbook.
