- **After School Movies** - Twice a year students get to watch a movie in the cafeteria for a small fee. Drinks and snacks will be provided. Volunteers needed to create flyers, monitor children, monitor sign-ups, check in/out children, pick up snacks and pass out snacks.
- **Art Vista** - Art Vistas is a parent-run program that gets art education into our school. All lessons and projects are taught and guided by parent volunteers. Parent volunteers also run the program at the school, ordering supplies, preparing supplies for projects, picking up the prints from the Art Vistas office, putting on the Art Show at the end of the school year, and supporting classroom docents.
