- a. Grants requested:
 - i. Kimochis: \$800
 - ii. Headsets needed for all students. To get \$600 headsets the cost is \$11,000.
 - iii. Would like to make use of makers space for more than one purpose. Especially during rainy days. Priority is to get a new projector and get rid of the old one.
 - iv. Make improvements to cafeteria to make it a multipurpose room. Will help with events and shows. The ask is \$4K.
- b. LCAP report: It means continuous improvement. It is a 3-year strategic plan. Helps all kinds of students.
