- H. Mrs. Barocio reads and responds to all emails - if more time is required for a response, allow that extra time

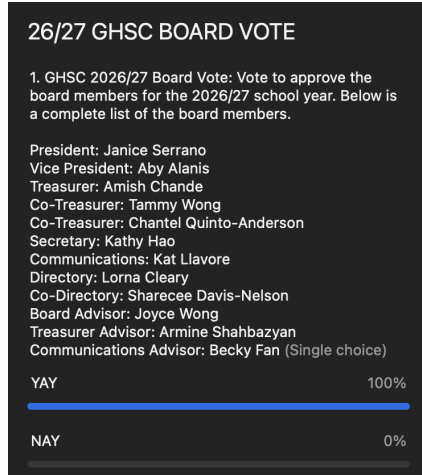
